

## **Notes on Tournament Brackets:**

Game 12 (26 for the lower bracket) may need a double-header to determine who continues in the tournament. If the team from the loser's bracket wins Game 12 (26 for the lower bracket), then another game (Game 12A or 26A) will immediately follow between the same two teams. The winner of that game continues in the tournament.

**The team from the winner's bracket will be the home team for both games.**

Should the team from the winner's bracket win Game 12, then Game 14 (28 for the lower bracket) may need a double-header to determine who continues in the tournament. If the team from the loser's bracket wins Game 14 ((28 for the lower bracket), then another game (Game 14A or 28A) will immediately follow between the same two teams. The winner of that game continues in the tournament.

**The team from the winner's bracket will be the home team for both games.**

In Game 29, should one team have one loss and the other no losses, the team with one loss must defeat the team with no losses twice. The second game will immediately follow the first. **In this case the team with no losses will be the home team for both games.**

In the event that there is a double-header, a pitcher may pitch in both games. **If he pitches in both games**, he may not pitch in more innings than the number of innings in a normal game in his class (C, D – 5 innings, B – 6 innings, A- 7 innings).two games. A single pitch in an inning counts as an inning pitched.
